DAY 1 MONDAY, OCTOBER 14

RENO, NV

(Dinner)

Today we will meet at the airport for our flight to **Reno, NV**, the "Biggest Little City in the World." Upon our arrival (depending on flight schedule), time will be available to explore this booming hub with endless things to eat, see, and experience. We'll end our day by settling into the **Hilton Garden Inn** for the next two nights and freshening up for a wonderful welcome dinner.

DAY 2 TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15

RENO, NV

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Following breakfast our day will begin with a **guided walking tour**. We will delve into the ways downtown Reno has reinvented itself over the past 150 years and hear stories of the forces that shaped the town. Mining, the railroad, immigration, and Reno's reputation as a gambling mecca all played a significant role. Up next is the **National Automobile Museum**, which explores the history of the automobile through the ages. More than 225 antique, vintage, and classic cars are on display, ranging from a 1907 Thomas Flyer and limited editions to celebrity-owned vehicles and speed record setters. Then we'll enjoy some free time to grab lunch on our own and browse the unique collection of shops in the Riverwalk District. This downtown district is a symbol of Reno's urban renaissance! Our attention will then turn to the natural beauty found at the **Wilbur D. May Arboretum & Botanical Garden**. The garden is home to a diverse plant community, beautiful garden layouts, and ever-changing foliage. Dinner this evening will be enjoyed as a group.

DAY 3 WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16

LAKE TAHOE, NV

(Breakfast, Lunch)

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we depart for **Virginia City, NV**, an Old West town famous for the 1859 Comstock Lode silver ore discovery. A **narrated trolley tour** awaits us here to introduce us to this historic town and its most popular landmarks. We'll then discover the real story of life in a booming western mining town with a visit to the **Historic Fourth Ward School**. Built in 1876, this four-story, wooden building held nearly a thousand students and boasted state-of-the-art heating, ventilation, and sanitation systems with water piped to all four floors. Today, the school is home to a museum with fascinating exhibits on the Comstock, mining, letter press printing, and the history of the school and its alumni. Lunch will be enjoyed at a local restaurant before we make our way to the **Mackay Mansion**, an authentic Victorian-era home with a paranormal past. Keep your eyes peeled for the ghostly residents who have landed the mansion on the shows *Ghost Adventures* and *Dead Files*! Our journey will then continue with the short drive south to **Lake Tahoe** to check in to **Harrah's Casino** for a two-night stay. The remainder of the day is yours to stroll along the cobblestone sidewalks, browse the unique blend of local and national brands at **Heavenly Village**, and have dinner at your leisure.

DAY 4 THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17

LAKE TAHOE, NV

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast we are off to the capital of Nevada, **Carson City**! Our first stop will be the **Stewart Indian School Cultural Center and Museum** to discover the school's complicated past and learn about the history and culture of the Native children who were educated here. Lunch will be at a local eatery before we head to the **Nevada State Museum** featuring the historic Carson Mint, a replica mine, the USS Nevada silver service, and an impressive collection of fossils and minerals. Once back in Lake Tahoe, we will **board the MS Dixie II paddlewheeler for an amazing sunset dinner cruise**. The evening promises breathtaking views over Emerald Bay, superb cuisine, and wonderful live music!

DAY 5 FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18

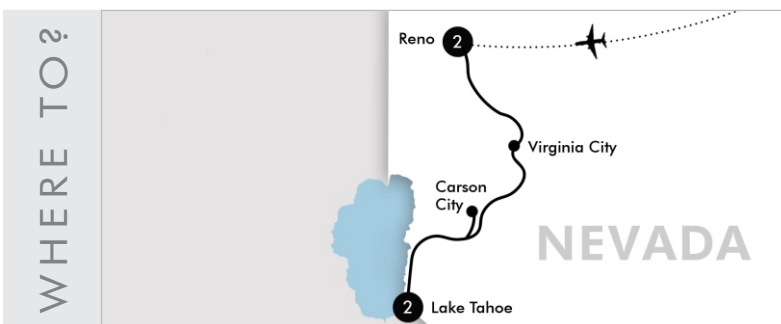
