THURSDAY, OCTOBER 1

We begin our fabulous autumn tour of **New England** with a flight to **Burlington, Vermont**, home to the University of Vermont. We'll check into the **Hotel Champlain Burlington Curio by Hilton** for a three-night stay. Enjoy dinner on your own this evening at one of the city's many restaurants.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 2 (Breakfast, Dinner)

Our day begins with a journey into the heart of autumn in New York and Vermont. After breakfast, we'll board the **Lake Champlain Ferry**, gliding from Charlotte, Vermont to Essex, New York as wooded shorelines glow with fiery reflections on the water. From the New York shore, we continue into the **Adirondacks**, arriving in **Lake Placid** for a **guided tour** of the **Lake Placid Olympic Center**. See the iconic venues firsthand where Olympic dreams were made at the 1980 Winter Olympics, including the legendary Miracle on Ice Hockey game. Next, you'll have time to take in the lakeside views of this charming village and enjoy lunch on your own before we continue north to **Plattsburgh** for our return ferry crossing to Vermont's **Lake Champlain Islands**. See rolling countryside and colorful vineyards as we make our way to **Snow Farm Vineyard & Distillery**. Here we savor the local flavors and take in the gorgeous views during our **wine tasting and guided tour**. Consider taking a short walk through the historic farm to Fox Hill where you can take in breathtaking sunset views of the island. As evening falls, we venture over to the **Blue Paddle Bistro** for dinner at this charming restaurant nestled on beautiful **South Hero Island**.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3 (Breakfast, Dinner)

This morning we take a short drive south to the **Shelburne Museum**, the largest art and history museum in northern New England. We'll stroll the 45-acre campus, which is home to 39 historic houses, barns, a schoolhouse, a lighthouse, a jail, a covered bridge, and the 220-foot steamboat *Ticonderoga*. The museum's buildings boast more than 150,000 works of art including French impressionist paintings, furniture, duck decoys, pottery, quilts, and more.

Our next stop will be at the nearby **Vermont Teddy Bear Factory** where we will take a **guided tour**. See first hand how the Vermont Teddys are assembled, visit the Bear hospital, and learn about the company's history as the longest-standing Made in America teddy bear factory. Then, we'll return to Burlington to explore **Church Street Marketplace**, an award-winning pedestrian mall home to over 100 stores and restaurants. The afternoon is yours to find the perfect souvenir, walk the nearby Waterfront Park, check out local artists at the Burlington City Arts Center, or relax back at the hotel.

This evening, we'll embark on the **Spirit of Ethan Allen** for a **Harvest Dinner Sunset Cruise** on **Lake Champlain**. Our luxury cruise ship offers three unique decks to enjoy panoramic views of the lake and the Vermont mountains. Once on board we will watch the moon rise over **Lake Champlain**, enjoying a hearty, seasonal plated dinner service as we pass **Lone Rock Point, Juniper Island, Rock Dunder, and Shelburne Bay**. Take in the arresting sights of the hues of autumn—amber, russet, gold, and crimson painting the shorelines along every bend. After we disembark, the remainder of the evening is yours to relax and enjoy a casual night in Burlington.





SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4 (Breakfast, Dinner)

Today we'll experience beautiful autumn foliage and a few of Vermont's delectable treats! First, we'll visit **Cold Hollow Cider Mill**, known for its fresh-pressed apple cider and famous cider donuts. Then we stop by **Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory**, where we'll take a **guided factory tour** before tasting their richly decadent ice cream. Our next stop is the **Morse Farm Maple Sugarworks**. The Morse ancestors helped settle central Vermont and were taught how to tap maple trees by Native Americans. Learn about the process of maple sugaring and experience a tasty Vermont custom called **sugar-on-snow**. For lunch, you'll find many delightful cafés featuring farm-to-table freshness in **Montpelier**. Then we're off to experience the gorgeous scenery of the **White Mountains of New Hampshire**. This afternoon we arrive in **Bretton Woods** and check into the fabulous four-star **Omni Mount Washington Resort** for two nights! As grand as the history behind it, the Omni Mount Washington Resort is gracious in ambiance and generous in amenities. This hotel has been a favorite New England retreat of presidents, poets and celebrities. We'll experience enchanting music, refined dining, and luxurious décor. Dinner is included at the resort this evening.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 5 (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, we'll set out to enjoy New England's fall colors. A **local guide** will take us along the famous **Kancamagus Highway**, the only federally designated "scenic byway" in New England. We will make several photo stops along the way at covered bridges, waterfalls and scenic overlooks. After a beautiful day exploring the New England countryside, we return to the hotel where you have time to admire the lovely grounds, enjoy the hotel's amenities, and relax before we enjoy another delectable dinner at the resort.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 6 (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast, we travel to **Portland, Maine**. Here you'll find a variety of tasty lunch options along the waterfront. Then we'll visit the iconic **Portland Head Light**, situated along the spectacular shore of Fort Williams Park and offering some of the most dramatic photograph opportunities in New England. Commissioned by George Washington, this lighthouse has become the jewel of Maine's rugged coastal landscape. We'll pass the unique **Wedding Cake House**, the "most photographed house in Maine," before visiting the quaint town of **Kennebunkport** to stroll its shopping district. Later today we arrive in **Ogunquit** and check into the charming **Anchorage by the Sea** for one night. Tonight we're treated to a New England classic - a Maine Lobster Bake - at the hotel's **Surf Point Restaurant**. You may want to take a walk on the beautiful **Marginal Way**, a path that runs along our hotel's lawn and continues along the rugged coast.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 7 (Breakfast)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we make our way to **Boston** for a **guided city tour**. We'll learn about the role the city played in our nation's founding and see an abundance of historical sights - including the **Paul Revere statue**, **Old North Church**, **Boston Common**, and the **USS Constitution** - the world's oldest commissioned warship afloat. Afterward, we make our way to the Boston airport for our flight home. We'll be taking with us warm, fall-colored memories of beautiful New England!
