



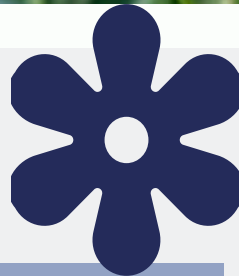

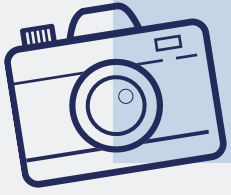

Trip Spotlight

ICELAND'S MIDNIGHT SUN: GLACIERS AND GEYSERS

Join us May 23- June 1, 2027 on this extortionary tour - magical Iceland! Day 1, set out on a journey full of dramatic contrasts. Come to know Iceland, a place where steaming lava fields reflect a volcanic nature and massive glaciers sculpt mountains and valleys, leaving behind thundering waterfalls and plunging fjords. Learn about geothermal renewal energy on a visit to Hellisheidavirkjun, the geothermal power station in the world. Visit Lava Exhibition Center and delve into Iceland's past and present volcanic eruptions. Afterwards, witness Seljalandsfoss, a rushing waterfall where you may walk behind the water for unique views from the inside out. Listen to mysterious stories about this area or capture a photo of one of the most picturesque lighthouses in the world. Drive along the scenic south shore to the Skogar Museum. Discover its turf-built houses and its collection of farm and domestic artifacts. Stop at a family-run dairy farm to enjoy various cheeses and their famous ice cream during a light lunch. We will travel to Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon, marvel at the vistas and snowy mountain peaks as you board a cruise on an amphibian boat along the huge icebergs. Explore this extraordinary landscape as you search for seals swimming in cold waters. We will make our way back to Reykjanes Peninsula. Visit a local studio and learn about Icelandic tradition of geothermal sweeping ocean views. This 10 day tour offers so much more and is truly a trip of a life time!
